On Friday we left Oxford in the morning to visit the marvellous London. We had a guide that walked us through the most famous places in the capital. For a full London experience, rain was obviously included!

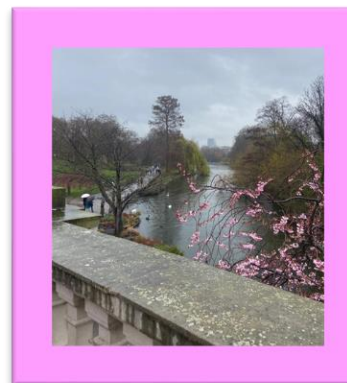


Buckingham Palace: so many people and so many umbrellas but still majestic. We even saw the London guards on duty!

At the end of the tour we had a few hours of free time and we decided to have lunch at **Five Guys**. Some of us were happier than others...

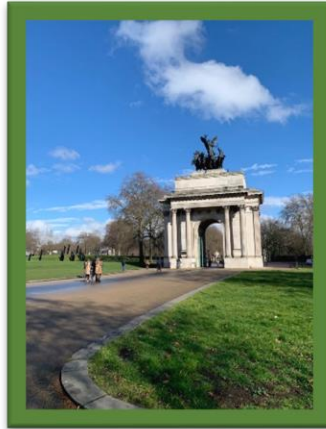
